

**TAX COMMISSIONER OFFICE**  
**2013 HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS**  
**(EXEMPTIONS MUST BE APPLIED FOR BETWEEN**  
**JANUARY 1 & APRIL 1 ) REGULAR HOMESTEAD**

Each resident of Glynn County, who is a homeowner and who reside on the property, is eligible for regular homestead exemption. Mobile Home owners may apply if they own both land and mobile home, and reside there.

**SENIOR EXEMPTIONS**

Each resident of Glynn County who is a senior citizen (62 years or older) is granted an exemption from ad valorem taxes for county purposes in the amount of, either (L3) \$8,000 off the assessed value of the homestead regardless of income; or (L4) \$10,000 off the assessed value if that person's GA net income, together with the income of the spouse of such person (who resides within said homestead), does not exceed \$20,000 for the immediate preceding year. **Home owners shall not receive either A or B unless an affidavit is filed with the tax office by either the home owner or their acting agent.**

**SCHOOL EXEMPTION**

Homeowners who are 62 years of age or older on January 1, 2013, and, who meet the following requirements are entitled to a school exemption on the first \$10,000 and \$2,000 for county purposes. a) The property must be in the name of the applicant (s), b) The net income of the applicant(s), the spouse, and all residents of the household, shall not exceed \$10,000. Social Security, Retirement, Pension and Disability benefits up to in the amount of \$60,792 are excluded from the calculation of net income.

**ADDITIONAL EXEMPTION FROM SCHOOL AD VALOREM TAX**

Homeowners who are 65 years of age or older on January 1, and whose net income together with the income of the spouse does not exceed \$40,000 on the GA State Income Tax for the immediately preceding year may claim an additional exemption from School Ad Valorem Tax. **The deadline for filing for this exemption is April 1.** Proof of Income (State, Federal Tax Return). If GA State and Federal Income Tax is not required to be filed, then documents reflecting the total Household Income **must be submitted** (Social Security, Retirement..etc.) **Social Security Number and GA I.D. with Glynn County address are required** (New voted on November 2008). **This exemption is income based and must be applied for yearly.**

**FULL EXEMPTION**

Homeowners who are 65 years of age or older on January 1, 2013, and, who meet the following requirements are entitled to a \$4,000 homestead exemption for county purposes and a \$10,000 homestead exemption for school purposes. a) The property must be in the name of the applicant(s). b) The net income of the applicant(s), the spouse, and all residents of the household shall not exceed \$10,000 Social Security, Retirement, Pension and Disability benefits up to the amount of \$60,792 are excluded from the calculation of net income. When applying for full or school exemption the husband and wife's social security number, date of birth, and all sources of income for the year are required.

**VETERAN'S EXEMPTION**

The qualified Disabled Veteran may receive a \$64,960 exemption. Inquiries about qualifications should be made at the Veterans Administration office in the Office Park Building located at 1803 Gloucester Street.

You may apply between the hours of 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday in the Tax Commissioner's Office located at 1725 Reynolds Street, Suite 100, Brunswick, GA 31520. The deadline for applying is April 1,
